Crevier's School of Cosmetology has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA (a)(4) program to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

The institution will receive \$98,313.00 from the Department pursuant to the Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA (a)(4) program.

\$98,313.00 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants have been disbursed as of the date of this report.

An estimated 51 students are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA (a)(4) program.

72 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the CRRSAA (a)(4) program.

Any student enrolled full time at the time the fund distribution began (May 1, 2021) is eligible to apply for an Emergency Financial Aid Grant. The institution requires each student applying for an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to submit a FAFSA from the current award year. Once the students FAFSA has been received successfully with an EFC score, the institution will determine the appropriate grant amount based on the student's need. The student's need will be based off their current EFC score. The institution has broken down the grant amounts into three categories. The table for determining grant amount based on EFC score will be posted below.

Students are instructed that the Emergency Financial Aid Grants are to be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care.

*As of 1/1/2022, the remaining funds were not enough to award students with the above amounts. The remaining funds were distributed to students by prorating by how many students in each EFC score range. The funds were distributed as follows.

- 5 students had an EFC score range of 10000<, 4 were given \$502.33 each and the remaining student was given \$502.30
- 2 students had an EFC score range of 5712-10000, they were given \$602.80 each.
- 14 students had an EFC score range of 0-5711, they were given \$703.27 each.
