

This is the final report that covers all remaining HEERF fund expenditures for Section 18004(a)(1) Student Portion funds

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund

1. Crevier's School of Cosmetology has signed and returned to the Department of Education, the Certification and Agreement and has used no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The institution has received \$94,150.00 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
3. 42 Emergency Financial Aid Grants, totaling \$94,150.00 have been distributed to students as of the date of submission. Each eligible student received \$2027.39 plus \$500 per each dependent they claim.
4. There are currently 42 students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
5. 42 students total have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant.
6. The institution allotted \$500 per dependent of each student eligible for an Emergency Financial Aid Grant. Once we knew how many dependents to account for (18), we divided the rest of the funds equally among the 42 eligible students so they were each able to receive \$2027.39 each in addition to \$500 per dependent they claim.
